Yea! We had 9 members and 3 gusts at last weeks meeting. Merrill Birge and Lauren Delatorre gave us an excellent presentation on "Save Our Skies". Although the Airport has been there for many years, (It was originally an Airforce base), The major concern is the growth of Jets that are projected to be using Camarillo Airport in the future. Currently there is 100 local operation jet landings and 7,582 itinerant jet landings a year which is about 9.5% of the total operations but the forecast shows that by 1942, there will be 180 local and 23,318 jets using the airport during the year which will be around 22% of the total operations. If you live anywhere near the flight path the increase in noise will be more than doubled. There will be presentation's at the City Council meeting this Wednesday which will be held at Camarillo Library 6:00 pm. If you are interested in hearing more about the future of the Airport please attend.
